## **OBLIGATIONS OF OWNER/OPERATOR OF THE AIRCRAFT**

Obligations of the owner/operator of the aircraft are shown in **Instructions for Continued Airworthiness**, which are delivered with the aircraft.

- 1. The owner/operator of the aircraft will read, understand and observe Operating Manuals, Maintenance Manual and Instructions for Continued Airworthiness provided by the manufacturer.
- 2. The owner/operator of the aircraft is responsible for provision of contact information to the manufacturer, which will be used by the manufacturer for sending of additional airworthiness information (e.g. Bulletins).
- 3. The owner/operator of the aircraft is responsible for reporting to the manufacturer of all safety flight problems or found significant operating problems.
- 4. The owner/operator of the aircraft is responsible for completion of notifications about corrective measures of Service Alert / AD, Service Bulletin and all airworthiness regulations with regard to maintenance of the aircraft airworthiness.
- 5. The owner of the aircraft ensures the performance of any necessary required corrective actions either according to the requirement of corrective action, or at next scheduled annual inspection.
- 6. If the aircraft owner/operator does not complete a mandatory service requirement, then the aircraft will be considered for not compliance with applicable airworthiness regulations and can be inflicted by regulatory measure of an airworthiness authority.
